- ◇ The hot tub leak has been repaired. Pasco County credited us \$170.43 on our March water bill.
- ◇ A motion was passed to extend the 10% rental fee (always paid by Zumba and Yoga) to anyone charging a fee for services using club facilities, which includes the tennis courts and pool.
- ◇ The Board will investigate alternative methods for paying monthly club dues.
